Equine Therapy – Code HORSE

- Mission Statement –
 - Provide world-class Equine Therapy programs, workshops, and retreats for women Veterans, First Responders, and their Families living with Post Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD), Traumatic Brain Injuries, and Service-Related Injuries.
- Code HORSE program began in 2013
- TCWV relationship with Code HORSE began in April 2022
- Transitioned to new ownership late 2024
 - New Owners – Jamie Simison (LCSW) & Rob Simison
 - Same location – Saddles Ranch in Umatilla
 - Cher Myers continues to provide assistance & guidance
- To date, 34 women veterans have attended equine assisted therapy

What Programs Does Code HORSE Offer?

#1 Reboot– an immersive program designed as a reset in the healing and wellness journey of women veterans

- Two 6-Hour Days
- Must have at least 4 veterans/class
- Horses are masters at reading body language, intent, and emotion. The complete and honest feedback of the horse is the special ingredient that makes Equine Therapy so powerful.

#2 Wellness & Maintenance – at discretion and interest of graduates

- Must have completed Reboot Program to take this class
- One day for 2.5 hours
- Must have at least 4 veterans/class
- Incorporates the favorite parts of the Reboot Program
 - Reconnecting with the horses & the comradery with other women veterans
